1. We would ask that your Son travel to and from the Holiday in his BB Jumper (Junior Section only).
2. Suitcases are not acceptable.
3. Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing.
4. Please label with either indelible ink and/or engraving as appropriate, with your sons name. (The old favourites of paper labels held on with sellotape, or nail varnish dots are not suitable. The paper labels fall off after a short time or getting wet, and it's amazing how many mums use the same shade of nail varnish).
5. Mobile Phones (Company Section only), iPods, iPads, Nintendo DS's or similar items may be taken if so wished, however, no responsibility will be taken by The Boys' Brigade, or any of its staff for the item's loss or theft. Additionally Headphones must be worn for sound.
6. Any Medication taken on holiday should be clearly marked with boys' name and directions for administering the medication, and given to a member of staff before we depart, this includes Inhalers.
7. Mobile Telephones must not be taken on any Boys' Brigade trip by boys in the Junior Section, this is for security reasons and any boy found with one will have it immediately confiscated and returned at a later date.
8. These items may get dirty or very wet
9. Should be in compression bag if possible, if not it should be rolled tightly and tied with string – we have very limited space in the vehicles.
